

Kate Offenberger, DJFS Director, appeared before the Board to get the PRC Plan updated. There were a few minor changes to easy the interpretation of the plan. The 2017 Back to School Clothing Program - \$200 voucher per child under 18. The Program max is \$275,000. This runs from 7/1/17 to 9/30/17. They did add Shopko for a retailer. They will still continue to work with Kohls, but they have not been able to give us a line of credit at this time. The Ohio Youth Works Program name has been changed to Summer Youth Program for 14-15 year olds. This program previously did 16-24 year olds. That age has moved to a different group. We ended up putting a college student with the 14 and 15 year olds. They have to have a work permit signed off by the school superintendent. These are the two major program adjustments. The other change was the increase on the contingency (emergency help for those under 10% of poverty) the maximum amount went from \$800 to \$1200. If this money isn't used during the year, these funds are rolled over and allowed to be used on the clothing program. Every year we do a review of the plan to make sure we are meeting the needs of the community. This has to be done by October.
