


**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
2010 FORMULA CDBG PROGRAM**

The Carroll County Commissioners will hold a public hearing concerning the FY10 Formula CDBG Program at 6 P.M. on March 11, 2010 in the Commissioner's office in the Carroll County Courthouse in Carrollton. The meeting will be to go over funding, applications, time frame, and project particulars. This is the time for interested parties to ask questions concerning possible projects and other program requirements. Application packets have been mailed to all villages and townships, and other interested parties. Anyone interested in receiving an application packet should contact the Clerk noted below.

The County expects to receive approximately \$120,000 in the coming year from the Ohio Department of Development (ODOD). It anticipates it will have slightly over \$90,000 for projects after administration and fair housing costs. The County is limited to funding no more than six projects. These funds must be spent on projects where the benefit will be primarily (51%) to persons and households under 80% of the median income for Carroll County.

The County has already held one hearing on all types of CDBG funded programs under ODOD. Citizens of Carroll County are encouraged to attend this public hearing and provide their input to the County's CDBG program. The County Courthouse is handicapped accessible. If a participant needs additional assistance due to a disability, or language, please contact the County Commissioners' office. It will hold one additional hearing later where it will announce the projects actually funded.
