NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Carroll County Commissioners hereby accepts the retirement of Ralph Castellucci as Director of Environmental Services effective April 30, 2017;

RESOLVED FURTHER that the Board hereby finds Mr. Castellucci to be the best candidate for the position of Director of Environmental Services and authorizes his rehiring to the same position effective May 1, 2017 under the following terms and conditions:

- All accrued vacation time and compensation (comp) time through April 30, 2017 shall be paid out. As of May 1, 2017, 1. vacation time will begin accruing as a new employee. Mr. Castellucci will not receive credit for prior years' service in determining the vacation accrual rate.
- All accrued sick leave through April 30, 2017 shall be paid out. As of May 1, 2017, sick time will start with a zero balance and Mr. Castellucci will accrue sick leave as a new employee.
- Mr. Castellucci will be a full time employee working 40 hours per week and will remain eligible for health insurance with Carroll County.
- Mr. Castellucci's salary as of May 1, 2017 shall be \$34.92 per hour, which is the same rate in effect upon his retirement.
- Mr. Castellucci is considered a classified employee and as of his rehire date of May 1, 2017 will receive no credit for prior service. He shall start a new period of classified service for the purpose of calculating service credits in the event of layoff or other action affecting employment.

Commissioner Ohler advised he has been thinking about the additional \$5.00 tax which can be charged where the benefit of that funding goes to the County Engineer for road maintenance. Commissioner Wirkner asked if this is a yearly \$5.00 fee at the time license plates are renewed. Commissioner Ohler answered yes, and the public would have to vote on the issue. Commissioner Mickley advised he understands it can be put before voters or the Board can enact it. Commissioner Ohler will invite Brian Wise, Engineer, to present his views then the Board will have to make the decision whether to put it before the voters. Commissioner Ohler advised he would prefer the voters pass or reject the tax. Commissioner Wirkner thinks \$5.00 is not a lot to get better roads.
