RESOLUTION #2018-14 A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NECESSITY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION ORC 5705.19, ORC 5705.191, ORC 5705.25, ORC 5705.26

The <u>Board of Commissioners</u> of <u>Carroll County</u>, Ohio, met in <u>regular</u> session on the <u>7th</u> day of <u>May</u>, 20<u>18</u>, at the office of <u>the</u> Board of County Commissioners, with the following members present: Robert E. Wirkner, Lewis A. Mickley, and Jeffrey L Ohler.

Mr. Mickley moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the **Board of Commissioners** of **Carroll** County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Board determines and declares that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient and that it is therefore necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of providing or maintaining senior citizens services or facilities (Friendship Center) as authorized by Section 307.694 or 307.85 of the Ohio Revised Code and pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 5705.19(Y), at a rate not exceeding 0.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to five (5) cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation for five (5) years (2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023), and which levy is a renewal of an existing levy of 0.5 mills.

Section 2. The question of approving the levy shall be submitted to the electors of the entire territory of Carroll County, Ohio at the election to be held on the 6^{th} day of November, 2018, and that said levy be placed on the tax lists of the current tax year, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020, in compliance with the provisions of ORC 5705.34, if a majority of the electors

Section 3. The Clerk of this Board is directed to certify immediately a copy of this resolution to the County Auditor of Carroll County requesting that the County Auditor certify to the Board the total current tax valuation of Carroll County and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated annually by the 0.5 mill levy.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open in the public, in compliance with law.
