WHEREAS, the Village of Amsterdam and contiguous areas of Springfield Township in Jefferson County and Loudon Township in Carroll County, Ohio have been mandated by Ohio EPA to eliminate failing on-site septic systems which are contaminating the environment and posing a health hazard to area residents;

WHEREAS, Jefferson County, through the Jefferson County Water and Sewer District will construct, own and operate a sewage treatment and collection system in the Village of Amsterdam and contiguous areas of Springfield Township in Jefferson County and Loudon Township in Carroll County to provide public sanitary sewer services to the affected areas;

WHEREAS, the Board of Health of the Carroll County Health District within which the new public sewer construction project is located in Loudon Township, has passed or will pass a Resolution in which it determined that the reason for the project is to reduce or eliminate an existing health problem or hazard of water pollution in Loudon Township; and

WHEREAS, the Carroll County Commissioners wish to resolve that it is necessary for all persons and properties served by the Amsterdam Sewer Project, in Loudon Township, Carroll County, to connect to the sewer lines of the Amsterdam Sewer Project unless specifically exempted by law from the requirement thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Carroll County Commissioners that:

All owners, agents, lessees, or tenants, or any other occupants (together generically referred to as "Occupants") of any premises located in Loudon Township in Carroll County, served by the Amsterdam Area Sewer Project shall connect to the sanitary sewer lines of the Amsterdam Area Sewer System unless specifically exempted from this Resolution under the provisions of O.R.C. 6117.51.

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- 2. This Board, by subsequent Resolution, shall direct its clerk, or the clerk's designee to serve orders of connection upon Occupants subject to the connection requirement upon notification from the Jefferson County Water and Sewer District that substantial completion has been reached on the construction project. Service of such orders shall be made in compliance with O.R. C. 6117.51.
- 3. The Occupants upon who service is made shall connect to the sewer line within ninety (90) days of service of the order of connection, unless compliance is waived or modified by this Board pursuant to O.R.C. 6117.51 upon timely written application made. Occupants shall make use of such connection and shall cease to discharge sewage or other waste into a cesspool, ditch, private sewer, privy, septic tank, semipublic disposal system or other outlet no later than ninety (90) days from the date of service of order of connection.
- 4. All installation and piping must meet the requirements of the Jefferson County Water and Sewer District.

RESOLUTION #2018-28 ESTABLISHING A PLAN FOR TIMELY CUSTOMER CONNECTIONS FOR THE AMSTERDAM SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM

WHEREAS, Jefferson County, Ohio intends to construct a Sanitary Sewer Collection and Treatment System (the Project) serving the Village of Amsterdam and contiguous areas of Springfield Township in Jefferson County, Ohio, and Loudon Township in Carroll County, Ohio.

WHEREAS, the sewer collection and treatment system will be owned by Jefferson County and operated by the Jefferson County Water and Sewer District.

WHEREAS, the objective of this plan is to require hook-up and payment of sewer bills by all customers in a manner consistent with the public health and financial obligations of Jefferson County and it is necessary to establish procedures for initiation of sewer billings following substantial completion of the Project, and

WHEREAS, Jefferson County will periodically levy sewer rates based on water consumption to generate revenues to cover capital, operating, maintenance, and replacement costs associated with the Project, and

WHEREAS, Jefferson County will have in effect a system for issuing sewer billings and collecting revenues, and

WHEREAS, within the proposed service area, Jefferson County will provide laterals for existing structures to the street right-of-way line and any necessary construction on private property will be the responsibility of the individual property owner.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Carroll County Board of Commissioners, Carroll County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1: That all customers of the Amsterdam Sanitary Sewer System will be notified by mail of substantial completion of said system, immediately after Jefferson County's engineer certifies that substantial completion has been achieved.

Section 2: That the notification of substantial completion will stipulate that sewer billings will commence not more than 30 days following substantial completion, and that said sewer billings will be due and payable in accordance with the billing policies adopted by the Jefferson County Water and Sewer District.

Section 3: That Resolution #2018-26 mandated that any existing dwelling within the service area is required to connect to the sewer system and that the letter from the Jefferson County Health Department and Carroll County Health Department mandated that, according to Ohio Revised Code Section 6117.51, any existing dwelling within 200 feet of a sewer collection line is required to connect to the sewer system. Existing dwellings, in the Village of Amsterdam, Springfield Township, Jefferson County or Loudon Township, Carroll County and within 200 feet of a sewer collection line are required to hook-up within 60 days after notification of substantial completion. Section 4: That the County will participate, as appropriate, in programs to provide financial assistance to qualifying low income and senior citizen customers within the service area in order to construct lateral connections behind the right-of-way line, to properly decommission existing septic tanks, and to make necessary modifications to plumbing within residences. These programs for financial assistance are provided by USDA/Rural Development, the Ohio Department of Development, and Jefferson and Carroll Counties. It is understood that all these programs furnish assistance to individual customers, rather than to the Counties. However, resources will be available to facilitate applications by qualifying individual customers. A public meeting will be held in the future to further educate the customers of these programs.

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RESOLVED FURTHER that this Board of Commissioners hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board which resulted in this formal action were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including ORC 121.22.
