There were a total of 2078 criminal and civil cases filed in the Carroll County Municipal Court under Judge Gary L. Willen during 2018.

These included 428 civil complaints and small claims actions, 1650 criminal and traffic cases.

Of the 1650 criminal and traffic actions, there were 112 felonies, 471 misdemeanors, 125 driving while intoxicated charges, and 942 other traffic citations.

A breakdown of the filings of the 1650 cases included: 693 by the Sheriff's Department, 300 by the Ohio State Highway Patrol, 75 by the Dog Warden, 17 by the O.D.N.R., 11 by the Lake Patrol, 427 by the Carrollton Police Department, 114 by other police agencies, and 13 by individuals.

Receipts in the Carroll County Court during 2018 total \$717,247.50 – 720,283.96 was paid to the following agencies: \$306,229.47 to the County for fines, \$8,393.50 to the State for fines, \$12,902.50 to the Sheriff's Department for sheriff fees and drug fines, \$4,620.00 to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for Game Warden and Division of Forestry fines, \$630.00 to the State of Ohio for expungement of files, \$3,390.00 to the State of Ohio for seatbelts, \$322.75 to the State for liquor fines, \$50,560.60 to the State for Rotary fees, \$11,297.00 to the State for Legal Aid Societies Fund, \$853.58 for Trusteeship creditors & Rent Escrow Accounts, \$1,658.49 to the State Board of Pharmacy for drug fines, and \$319,426.07 was paid out for garnishment payments, various villages for ordinance fines, and deposit refunds. The Court has received \$119,234.75 through our website payments and Capital Recovery Systems has collected \$65,343.91 on delinquent monies due the court.

A total of 256 new individuals were placed on probation in 2018. A total of 4638 hours of community service were performed. A total of \$61,886.50 was collected as a contribution in lieu of community service pursuant to O.R.C. 2929.27. A total of \$43,603.62 was collected in probation fees, and \$8,983.24 in restitution was collected and paid directly to victims through the probation department.

The Court's balance on hand as of December 31, 2018, is \$76,240.82
