## CARROLL COUNTY GUARDRAIL REPLACEMENT, PHASE 2



Brian J. Wise, Engineer, appeared before the Board to discuss the bids received February 4, 2019 for the Carroll County Guardrail Replacement, Phase 2. He explained that the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) recommends rejecting all bids and rebidding due to several factors. First, the low bidder did not complete the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) plan required by ODOT so the bid was rejected as non-responsive. The second lowest bidder did complete the DBE plan and was under the 10% threshold, but it was discovered the bid was not advertised through the local newspaper.

Commissioner Wirkner asked Brian J. Wise, Engineer, if he had a figure for the base material for the Route 9 Tower driveway. Mr. Wise advised he is waiting for the driveway to either freeze or dry up so he can view it. Commissioner Wirkner explained the Engineer's Office will do the grading work and the public purpose for this project is that the Board provides tower space for the Engineer's communications equipment at no charge.

### IN THE MATTER OF 2018 ANNUAL REPORT CARROLL COUNTY ENGINEER



Brian J. Wise, Engineer, appeared before the Board to present his 2018 annual report. A copy of the report is on file in the Commissioners' Office. He discussed the increased rainfall over the last year which impacted the County roads. Mr. Wise's report included the 2018 revenue of \$4,485,931.87 and \$4,282,857.12 in expenses. He discussed the maintenance completed and scheduled for roads, bridges, and culverts in the County. Mr. Wise said there was approximately 9,400 tons of wintermix put down and 46 callouts in 2018. Mr. Wise advised he was very proud of his staff for completing everything they did since they were understaffed in 2018. Mr. Wise advised his department purchased a new Western Star plow truck and expects to begin replacing sign trucks in 2019.

## IN THE MATTER OF LETTER OF SUPPORT - GAS TAX



Commissioner Ohler feels the Board should send a letter to legislators in support of the gas tax. He asked Mr. Wise if he knew the percentage of change the tax would total. Mr. Wise thinks about 50% or \$1.7 million for the County alone, with another \$90,000-\$150,000 for townships. Mr. Wise advised if the tax goes through, he plans to use the funds to level some roads and pave. Commissioner Wirkner said this initiative would improve the quality of the County's roads and bridges. Commissioner Mickley advised he sees the benefit of the tax but, as a representative of the people, most residents do not want to see more taxes. Mr. Wise explained there is no other mechanism in place except license plate fees. For this small County, the license plate fees do not generate enough to offset the fuel fees (fuel fees are 2/3 of the budget and license plates are 1/3).
