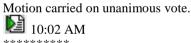
- Carroll County Genealogical Society to republish the Illustrated Historical Atlas of Carroll County, \$2,530 Status: Project complete
- Magnolia Area Historical Society to hold a Magnolia Treasures and Tours, \$2,000
- Status: Project complete Carroll County Agricultural Society to renovate the Open Class Dairy Barn, \$31,810

Status: The foundation and structure have been restored using almost \$24,000 of the funds. The remaining funds will be used to upgrade the electrical system.

- Carroll County Historical Society to repair/renovate the Perrysville Methodist Church, \$47,740 Status: Contract signed with work expected to begin in the spring of 2019
- 5. Malvern Historical Society to repair/renovate the Malvern Historical Society building, \$15,920 Status: Unable to find a contractor willing to accept the job
