



CARROLL COUNTY COURTS
Temporary Modification of Courthouse Operations
Effective March 17, 2020


In the interest of public health, and in order to comply with Ohio Governor Mike DeWine's Executive Order 2020-01D issued March 9, 2020, and the Order of the Ohio Director of Public Health issued March 12, 2020, the Courts will implement the following procedural changes beginning at 8:00AM on March 17, 2020, This is an evolving situation and may change pursuant to federal, state, or local guidance and directives.

1. The Courthouse will be open regular hours. Access MAY be temporarily refused by security staff to any visibly-ill person.
2. All individuals entering the Courthouse shall be subject to a non-invasive scan for elevated body temperature. Any individual including employees with an elevated temperature will be denied access to the Courthouse.
3. Any person who is not an attorney, prosecutor, law enforcement officer, plaintiff, defendant, subpoenaed witness, victim or victim advocate having business with the Courts may be limited to access to courtrooms and waiting areas.
4. Media shall have access in accordance with Ohio Sup. R. 12 per normal procedure.
