ADDENDUM OF LOCAL RULE 2.08 (D) OF COURT FOR COMMON PLEAS
GENERAL – TRIAL DIVISION, CARROLL COUNTY, OHIO

Under authority of Article IV, Section 5(B) of the Ohio Constitution, Rule 5 of the Rules of Superintendence for Courts of Common Pleas, and Local Court Rule 18. IT IS ORDERED that Rule 2.08 (D), of the Local Rules of Court, for the Court of Common Pleas, General – Trial Division for Carroll County, Ohio is hereby adopted, there being an immediate need for the rule.


Rule 2.08 - Methods of Service and Publication

D. Publication – Private Parties requesting legal notices shall prepare the legal notice and **prepay** the cost of the notice to the **legal publisher**. The requesting party is required to submit proof of payment and proof of publishing to the Clerk of Courts for filing. The prepaid cost may be taxed as costs in the case. The legal notice shall be prepared and submitted to the Clerk of Courts for endorsement **prior to publishing**.

This section does not apply to any county government or political-subdivision initiated request for service by publication; in which cases, the costs of publication shall either be ordered reimbursed and paid out of any proceeds from any judicial sale, if applicable, or paid out as court costs assessed on the conclusion of the case per order of the Court to the publisher.

This supplement to the local rule is adopted and replaces prior Rule 2.08 (D).
