The Carroll County Board of Commissioners is currently seeking individuals interested in serving on the Carroll County Board of Development Disabilities (CCBDD) Board of Directors. Individuals who are residents of Carroll County, Ohio, citizens of the United States, and are interested and knowledgeable in the field of developmental disabilities and other allied fields and is a relative of a person eligible for Early Intervention, Preschool, or School age services. Prospective board members should have professional training and experience in business management, finance, law, health care practice, personnel administration or government service.
