Melissa Schaar, Clerk appeared before the Board to advise that on Thursday, August 12, the U.S. Census Bureau released redistricting data from the 2020 decennial census. The data provides a great deal of information about local level demographics in communities throughout the state. It also allows the state to begin work on redrawing state and congressional district boundaries. The County Commissioners Association of Ohio (CCAO) has begun analyzing the Census figures and presented a comparison between 2010 and 2020 county population figures. Ms. Schaar advised that the comparison data shows Carroll County's official population at 28,836 in the 2010 Census and has decreased to 26,721 in the 2020 Census. Ms. Schaar advised that Ohio's population increased by approximately 263,000 (or 2.3%) between 2010 and 2020, significantly slower than the national rate of 7.4%. Overall, 33 counties saw their populations increase and the remaining 55 experienced a population decrease. Ms. Schaar advised that Delaware County's population increased by 22.9% over the decade, the largest percentage increase in the state.
