Wendy Dillingham, Senior Benefits Specialist for the County Employee Benefits Consortium of Ohio (CEBCO) appeared before the Board to give her 1st Quarter report for 2022. A copy of the report is on file at the Commissioners' Office. Ms. Dillingham presented a check to the Commissioners for \$3,000.00 from Anthem. Ms. Dillingham advised that there is a performance guarantee with Anthem which penalizes the insurance company for mistakes and poor performance. Ms. Dillingham advised that there were mistakes made by Anthem during open enrollment, therefore each county will receive a portion of the performance penalty. Commissioner Wirkner asked Ms. Dillingham if every county received the same amount. Ms. Dillingham advised that there were two counties who received more than the other counties because they had significant issues. Commissioner Wirkner asked Ms. Dillingham, to clarify if this is a reimbursement from Anthem for premiums. Ms. Dillingham advised no; this is a performance penalty given to the members of the consortium, so the money goes to the county fund. Ms. Dillingham advised that last year CEBCO added the Smartshopper Program which rewards members who are willing to shop around for their lab services, MRIs, and radiological services to find facilities that cost less for these procedures. Members get paid for saving CEBCO money. Ms. Dillingham advised that freestanding facilities are much cheaper for outpatient procedures than using an outpatient hospital. Ms. Dillingham advised that through the Smartshopper program, members will be provided information about cost and quality of each of the facilities within the mile radius the member chooses. Commissioner Wirkner advised that he heard that some individuals were asked to go over 50 miles to a freestanding location. Ms. Dillingham advised that they are not asked to travel that far, just advised about the significant savings if they are willing to drive that distance and there is no obligation to drive that far. Ms. Dillingham advised that last fall, CEBCO had several members share their stories about receiving money back from CEBCO for using the program.
