KOOKIN WITH KASEY

In honor of one of our favorite sports, here is a great recipe for tailgater's snack mix!

Ingredients:

- 9 cups Corn Chex, Rice Chex, or Wheat Chex cereal (or combination)
- 2 cups bite-size pretzel twists
- 2 cups bite-size cheese crackers
- 3 tablespoons butter or margarine
- 1 (1-ounce) package ranch dressing and seasoning mix
- 1/2 cup grated parmesan cheese

Directions

- 1. In large microwavable bowl, mix cereal, pretzels, and crackers.
- 2. In small microwavable bowl, microwave butter uncovered on high about 30 seconds or until melted.
- 3. Pour over cereal mixture; stir until evenly coated.
- 4. Stir in dressing mix and parmesan cheese until evenly coated.
- 5. Microwave uncovered on high 3 minutes, stirring after each minute.
- 6. Spread on waxed paper or foil to cool.
- 7. Store in airtight container. Makes about 26 servings
