Ms. Trbovich advised that one firm told her the boiler is too big, and she could go smaller. Ms. Trbovich advised she does not want to mess with sizing because the building was built according to state standards. Ms. Trbovich advised the only thing that needs replaced is the boiler, the piping is fine. Ms. Trbovich advised the State is coming today to do a building walk through. Ms. Trbovich advised she may be able to use an Ohio Department of Transportation grant, and she has some money in the Transit Reserve fund that can be used as a match. Commissioner Ohler asked if the threshold will be under \$50,000.00. Ms. Trbovich advised that based on the three estimates she received, it is under \$50,000.00.
