ODA **requires** all exhibitors who are exhibiting any and all Market, Lactating and Egg Laying animals in the state of Ohio complete Livestock Quality Assurance at least 45 days prior to the first day of exhibition. 2024 Carroll County Jr. Fair Rule Changes

1. **CHANGE** – JR. FAIR STILL PROJECT SALES, page 40 #4 a. **CHANGE** – Add art projects, and state that the framed and matted art/photo must be ready to hang. Clarify that the actual item must be 10”x12”, and does not include matting.
2. **CHANGE** – JR. FAIR STILL PROJECT SALES a. **CHANGE** – Merge the recipe card and product label, and on the rubric list the items that need to be included.
3. **CHANGE** – JR. FAIR STILL PROJECT SALES, page 40, #5C a. **CHANGE** – Reduce the sampling quantity to 1 dozen for baked goods and 2 dozen to sell, for a total of 3 dozen minimum.
4. **CHANGE** – JR. FAIR STILL PROJECT SALES, page 41 a. **CHANGE** – Change the food judging rubric to reflect the 3 dozen minimum total of baked goods that are required.
5. **ADD** – JR. FAIR STILL PROJECT SALES a. **ADD** – Exhibitors who have sold at least 3 years and are in good standing can opt out of Quality Assurance with the understanding that if they fail the rubric judging, do not meet deadlines, or dress improperly, they will not be permitted to sell at the auction.
6. **ADD** – RABBIT DEPARTMENT a. **ADD** – No decorations on wire of cages, only on white board below cage.
7. **ADD** – ALL LIVESTOCK DEPARTMENTS a. **ADD** – Market animals can only show in market classes and breed animals can only show in breed classes.
8. **ADD** – HOG DEPARTMENT, page 28, #3 a. **CHANGE** – Must be farrowed after December 1, 2023.
9. **CHANGE** – SHEEP DEPARTMENT, page 30, Class #11 a. **CHANGE** – Fleece must be shorn within the past year and owned by the exhibitor. Lamb fleeces are not acceptable. Each exhibitor may enter up to 5 fleeces.
10. **CHANGE** – BEEF DEPARTMENT a. **CHANGE** – Allow dairy steers to compete in the beef steer carcass contest.
11. **ADD** – CARCASS CONTEST a. **ADD** – All carcass animals must have cut sheets prior to being allowed to unload.
12. **CHANGE** – HORSE DEPARTMENT, page 25, #2 a. **CHANGE** – Horses must be stalled by 11 AM, and the horse vet check will be at 11:30 AM.

13. **ADD** – HORSE DEPARTMENT a. **ADD** – There will be a mandatory tack change before each discipline.

14. **CHANGE** – HORSE DEPARTMENT a. **CHANGE** – Horses cannot cross enter between western and ranch.

15. **ADD** – HORSE DEPARTMENT a. **ADD** – Add a groom and clean contest, which will follow Ohio 4-H Uniform Horse Rules.

16. **CHANGE** – HORSE DEPARTMENT a. **CHANGE** – Modify horse classes as presented.

17. **ADD** – ALL DEPARTMENTS a. **ADD** – To be eligible to participate in the Carroll County Jr. Fair, exhibitors must have their project books completed
