The successful bidder shall furnish to the County product information and specification sheets for the products to be bid:

- 2) Premium grade off-road (dyed) diesel fuel
- 3) Premium grade highway/on-road (un-dyed) diesel fuel

The bid margin shall include all of the supplier's costs, freight costs to their facility and delivery to location, as well as all PAT (Petroleum Activity Taxes, etc.), overhead and profit required. The bid margin price, per gallon, shall be firm for the entire term of this contract.

For the term of this contract, the **benchmark** price for each product will be determined as follows:

- -Supplier to submit the Fuel Cost Calculation Sheet provided by the County (Sample Attached) along with the OPIS Daily Price Report for each day gas or fuel is delivered.

In accordance with Section 6416 of the Internal Revenue Code, suppliers will assume the responsibility of filing of the federal gas tax refund or tax credit rather than passing it on to the County.

All products are subject to inspection/testing and approval as deemed necessary by the Carroll County Engineer. The expense of the inspection/testing is to be the responsibility of Carroll County if the product passes all tests. If the product fails said test then the cost is to be the responsibility of the bidder.

The Board of Commissioners reserves the right to waive any formalities, accept or reject any or all bids, and to determine the lowest and/or best bid. Eligible suppliers will be selected based on the information provided on the bid form and from the specification sheets provided.

All bids shall be on the "BID FORM" provided, shall be signed and include a Delinquent Taxes Affidavit. All bids must be sealed and plainly marked "BID –PETROLEUM FUEL PRODUCTS" and mailed or dropped off to the Carroll County Engineer's office as noted in the first paragraph above.

Minimum octane rating shall be 87 for regular unleaded. All #2 Diesel (both Un-dyed Highway and Dyed Off Road) shall be Ultra Low Sulfur Fuel and for use in Diesel Engine powered equipment and vehicles.

During winter months, fuel to be supplied with necessary additives for operation in cold weather. Suppliers are required to bid a set price per gallon for winter additives in their bid. This additional amount will be added to each gallon of diesel fuel delivered during cold weather months as requested by the county. Time period may vary, but will typically be from November thru March.
