The Carroll County Board of Elections (CCBOE) is accepting applications for the position of Clerk for the CCBOE. Clerks are responsible for performing administrative and/or clerical duties related to the election process as assigned by the Director, Deputy Director, or the Board. Other responsibilities include but are not limited to safely and properly lifting equipment and other items that may vary in range from 20-45 pounds, attending staff meetings and reviewing all Secretary of State Directives, Advisories, Memorandums, and other instructions as well as Board instructions and policy. Receiving and preserving all property belonging to the Board, including all books, papers, monies, records and reports. Assisting the public, candidates and elected officials with professionalism and answering election-relation questions. Entering and processing data specific to voter registration documents, absentee ballot requests, petitions, etc. as required by board policy and state and federal law.

To qualify candidates must be a registered Democrat elector in the state of Ohio with a high school diploma or equivalent. Successful candidates should possess strong communication, computer and organizational skills, have experience working with the public, understand the importance of confidentiality, and be willing to work extended hours during elections.

Applicants are subject to a criminal background check.
